of the Lord
April 17, 2022**



There are many stones in our paths that keep us from truly living and being free. Some of these boulders have been there for a very long time. They have been there so long that they have even settled into the soil of our lives with other weeds, vines, and compacted soil keeping them firmly in place. We find them hard to move and trying to do so can be exhausting. What are these suffocating albatrosses that keep us so tethered and immobile? They are many things. They are past childhood wounds and hurts that stem from disappointment, rejection, or abuse. People may have told us we were unwanted, that the world is frightening, that there are only some acceptable feelings you can have and others you cannot. We may have tried to love someone or struggled to figure out how and were met with rejection. Maybe we trusted someone completely and were betrayed. We come to life collecting barnacles that begin to attach to other barnacles and before you know it, we have a mass of solid matter blocking our vision and keeping us from moving. We live in fear. We are afraid of losing what we have, afraid that the future will be empty, afraid that we won't succeed and even more afraid that we will not be loved. There is so much fear. Didn't Jesus tell us not to worry and to not be afraid? Either we believe in the message of Easter, or we don't! Go confidently into the night. Walking with God you will find the light and strength you need. Often without even knowing, God will move those boulders and stumbling blocks that bind us and, with putting one foot in front of the other and looking forward, we will move. The resurrection of Christ is really all about receiving the gifts of trust and faith and doing new things. The rocks that bind us keep us spinning the same wheels and doing the same things. When was the last time you threw caution to the wind and actually did something totally out of character and different? This is where we find God, in the spontaneous, the adventurous, the fun, and the creative choices we make! God is not boring and stuck. God is exciting and engaging. Jesus Christ is risen from the dead! Find a way to trust that this is true and live.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

A God Who Knows How It Feels

Christ could have spoken anything from the cross, so why did he choose to recite Psalm 22? And why is it so important that we recite that same Psalm at today's Mass? "My God, my God, why have You abandoned me?" We've never known the Jesus of the Gospels to doubt the will of God. We've never known him to be a defeatist or to give into feelings of despair. He's the hero who walks on water, the Savior who is welcomed to Jerusalem with a pathway of palms. And he knows how this story ends; he knows full well that his Father has absolutely not abandoned him. So why does he say this? Jesus doesn't make offhanded comments, especially in his last hour. Today, when we repeat the words that he calls out in his darkest moment, we must remember that he wants us, very particularly, to consider them. With his crucifixion, Jesus reminds us of his humanity. He is a man of flesh that can be torn and blood that can be shed. Somehow, in tandem with his divinity, he still possesses a heart that knows fear and pain and longing. And with this seemingly hopeless cry, he reminds us of that. Let us never doubt that Jesus can relate to us in our brokenness. This is the week, friends. This is the week that reminds us that our God is a God who knows every pang, every trembling, and every uncertainty of human life. Our God knows what abandonment feels like. He knows what rejection feels like. He knows what it is to keep going when the strength and the will has disappeared.

Un Dios que sabe cómo se siente

Cristo pudo haber dicho cualquier cosa desde la cruz, entonces, ¿por qué eligió recitar el Salmo 22? ¿Y por qué es tan importante que recitemos ese mismo Salmo en la Misa de hoy? "Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?" Nunca hemos conocido que el Jesús de los Evangelios dudara de la voluntad de Dios. Nunca hemos visto que fuera un derrotista o que se entregara a sentimientos de desesperación. Él es el héroe que camina sobre el agua, el Salvador que es recibido en Jerusalén con un camino de palmas. Y él sabe cómo termina esta historia; sabe muy bien que su Padre no lo ha abandonado en absoluto. Entonces, ¿por qué dice esto? Jesús no hace comentarios improvisados, especialmente en su última hora. Hoy, cuando repetimos las palabras que pronuncia en su momento más oscuro, debemos recordar que quiere que, muy particularmente, las tengamos en cuenta. Con su crucifixión, Jesús nos recuerda su humanidad. Él es un hombre de carne que se puede desgarrar y de sangre que se puede derramar. De alguna manera, junto con su divinidad, aun posee un corazón que conoce el miedo, el dolor y el anhelo. Y con este grito aparentemente desesperado, nos lo recuerda. Nunca dudemos de que Jesús puede relacionarse con nosotros en nuestros propios quebrantamientos. Esta es la semana, amigos. Esta es la semana que nos recuerda que nuestro Dios es un Dios que conoce cada dolor, cada temblor y cada incertidumbre de la vida humana. Nuestro Dios sabe cómo se siente el abandono. Él sabe cómo se siente el rechazo. Él sabe lo que es seguir adelante cuando la fuerza y la voluntad han desaparecido.

Domingo de Pascua de la Resurrección del Señor

"Dios nuestro, que por medio de tu Hijo venciste a la muerte y nos has abierto las puertas de la vida eterna, concede, a quienes celebramos hoy la Pascua de Resurrección, resucitar también a una nueva vida. Renovados por la gracia del Espíritu Santo. Por nuestro Señor Jesucristo..." (Oración Colecta). El Mensaje de la Pascua resuena y se repite en cada una de las lecturas de la Eucaristía del día hoy. Hoy celebramos con gozo el día más grande del Calendario Litúrgico. Hoy cantamos alegres el Gloria y el Aleluya, porque Cristo, muerto y sepultado el Viernes Santo, ha Resucitado. Pongamos mucha atención en la secuencia que se proclama en este día y busquemos como María Magdalena al Señor: "¿Qué has visto en la mañana, María, en la mañana?". "A mi Señor glorioso, la tumba abandonada, los ángeles testigos, sudarios y mortajas. ¡Resucitó de veras mi amor y mi esperanza!". Corramos presurosos a buscarlo resucitado en la familia, en la escuela, en el trabajo, en los inmigrantes, en los enfermos, y lo más importante, en nuestro propio corazón. El Ángel también anima a las mujeres al llegar a la tumba: "Ustedes no tienen por qué temer. Yo sé que buscan a Jesús, que fue crucificado. No está aquí, pues ha resucitado, tal como lo había anunciado" (Mateo 28:5-6). "Esta es la culminación del Evangelio, es la Buena Noticia por excelencia: Jesús, el crucificado ha resucitado. Este acontecimiento es la base de nuestra fe y de nuestra esperanza. Jesús, el Amor encarnado, murió en la cruz por nuestros pecados, pero Dios lo resucitó y lo ha constituido Señor de la vida y de la muerte" (Papa Francisco). ¡Aleluya, Aleluya, Aleluya!

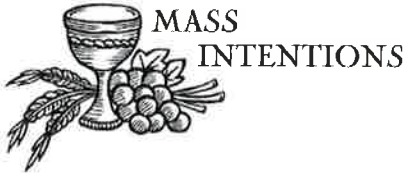

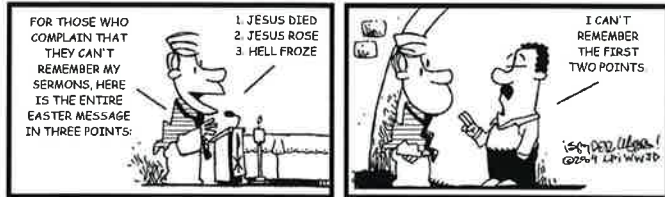

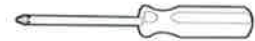
